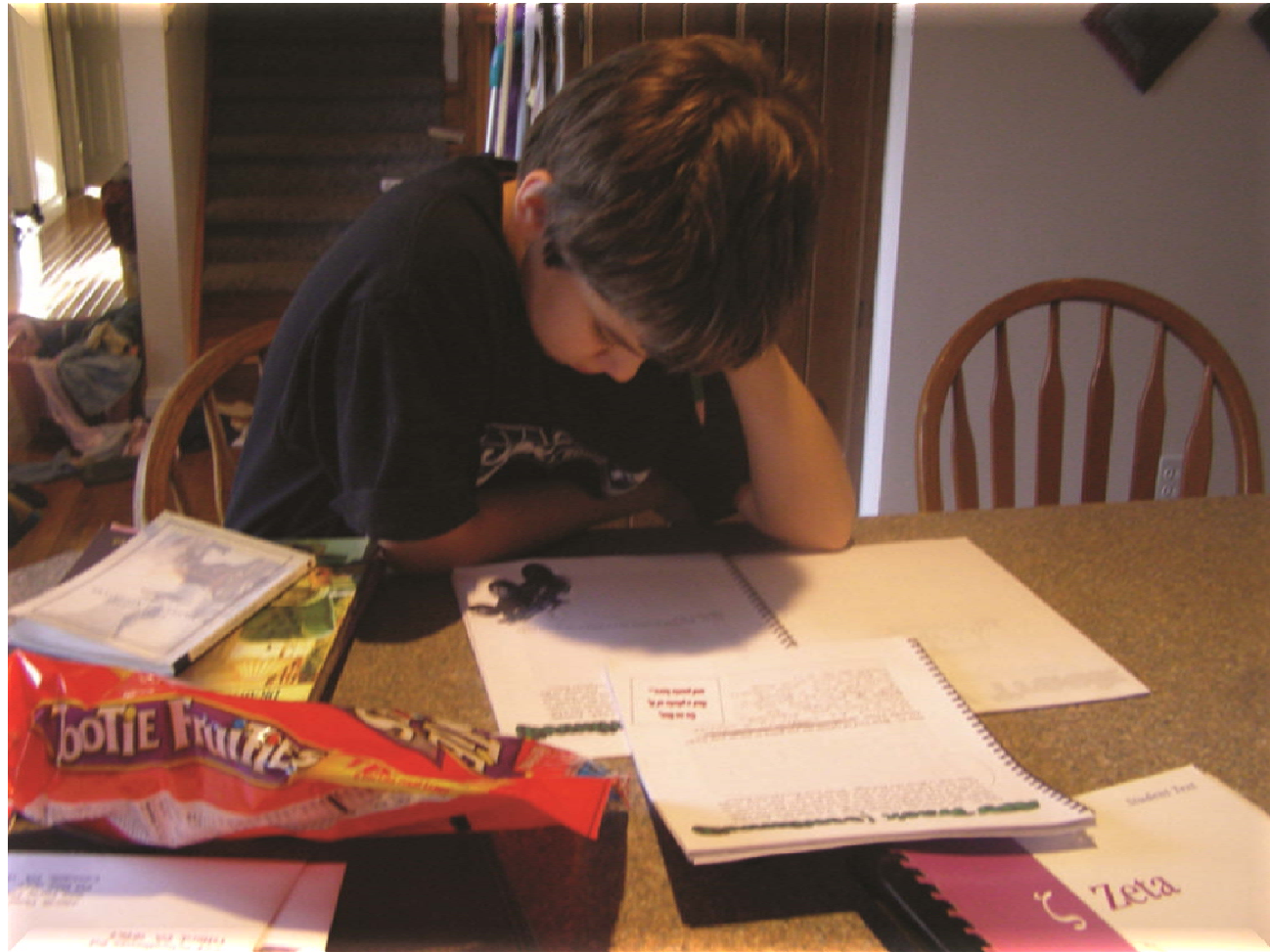
- Goal: the purpose toward which an endeavor is directed.
